CAPOST LEDS 2019-2020 Warranty Renewal Proposal (#: 2019-100)

Dear Ms. Crume,

Following up on our conversation in November, FAAC Incorporated (FAAC) is pleased to provide you with this proposal for continuing the LEDS warranty renewal for the period July 2019 through June 2020.

The presented plan is to maintain the current level of support and terms for annual warranty coverage for all CAPOST Regional Training Sites under a blanket agreement. This is a twelve (12) month commitment and renewable on an annual basis. This plan would maintain the existing warranty support terms (excluding trailers: The simulator equipment in the trailers is covered) which FAAC will continue to honor by providing in-state based technical personnel. This level of service exceeds FAAC's PREMIUM Warranty terms. Table 1 identifies the cost of this program:
