It also includes \$14.9 million to restore POST to its historical budget level prior to significant declines in fine and fee revenues since 2014-15. -Referenced from the California Department of Finance.

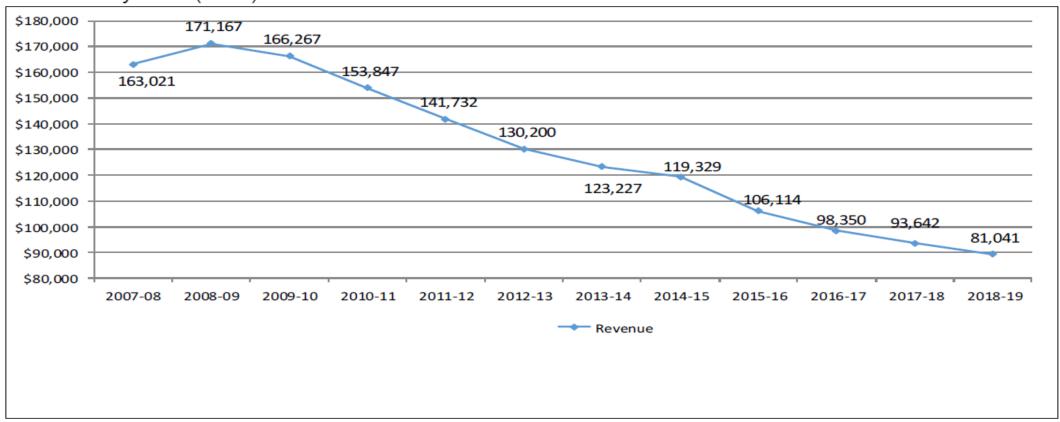
