On March 28, 2016 at 1850 hours, a house fire was reported at [REDACTED]. On arrival, the fire had fully engulfed the roof and second story of the house. Cpl. Todd, Officer Wu, and Officer Cordischi arrived on scene and were immediately told by neighbors there were people still inside the house. Without hesitation, the above mentioned officers rushed inside the house to search each room in an attempt to locate people who were unaware of the fire or unable to exit on their own. One of the residents was located on the garage roof with a water hose yelling that his mom, sister and pets were still inside. The officers were able to talk the resident down off the roof and reunite him with his mother and sister, who had already retreated to a neighbor's house.

Followed by successfully talking a panicked homeowner off his roof to avoid injuries to himself or a potential rescue operation.
