

Dear Mr. Ortiz:

This is in response to your application for the Basic Course Waiver (BCW) process. The BCW process is a waiver of attendance of the Regular Basic Course (RBC) and has the same standing in regulation as completion of the course in California. Completion of the BCW process is an option for meeting California's RBC training requirement for individuals who have law enforcement training and service in other states. POST records indicate that you completed California's RBC in April 2002. Therefore, you are not eligible for a waiver of attendance for a course that you have already completed.

Our records also show that you have not served as a peace officer in this state. Individuals who complete the RBC, but do not serve in a qualifying peace officer position for a three-year or longer period following completion of the course, are required to complete the Requalification Course prior to the exercise of the powers of a peace officer. Individuals who do not serve for a six-year period following completion of the RBC are required to complete the entire RBC to requalify. The requirement is codified in the Six-Year Exemption in Commission Regulation 1008(b)(2)(B)(1) which is part of state law under Title 11, Division 2 of the California Code of Regulations.

In February and again in March of this year, you requested an exemption from the Six-Year Exception. In each case our return correspondence explained that there is no provision in the law for the Commission to grant an exemption to the Six-Year Exception.

Because you do not qualify for a BCW, we are returning your money order and closing your file.
