Your request for an appeal to the POST Commission has been received.

Since all Commission meetings are open to the public, specific timelines are in place to ensure compliance with appropriate public meeting laws.

Pursuant to Regulation 1058, the Executive Director's decision may be appealed to the Commission. Appeals received with less than 45 calendar days remaining prior to the next scheduled Commission meeting are heard at a subsequent meeting.

Your request was received on May 26, 2016, which is outside the 45-day window necessary to meet the deadline to be placed on the agenda for the June 23, 2016, Commission Meeting. The 20-day timeframe you referenced addresses the specific appeals process, once the Commission appeal has been scheduled. The Commission cannot take action on items not on the agenda; therefore, your appeal will not be addressed at the June meeting.

Your appeal will be heard at the Commission meeting on October 27, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., and it will be held at the following location:

Your appeal will be heard pursuant to Commission Procedure D-16-1. You may appear before the Commission to make a statement, if you so desire.
