3.03.060 Recruitment and training - Cal. Penal Code § 13522.

- A. Sierra County declares that it desires to qualify to receive aid from the state of California under the provisions of Cal. Penal Code § 13522, Chapter 1, of Title 4, Part 4, of the California Penal Code.
- B. Pursuant to Cal. Penal Code § <u>13510</u>(c), Chapter 1, the Sierra County Sheriff will adhere to standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).
- C. Pursuant to Cal. Penal Code § <u>13512</u>, Chapter 1, the Commission and its representatives may make such inquiries as deemed appropriate by the Commission to ascertain that the Sierra County Sheriff's public safety dispatcher personnel adhere to standards for selection and training established by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

The Sierra County Code is current through Ordinance 1089, passed December 3, 2019.
