Article 4. Peace Officer Certification. § 1208. Temporary Suspension of Certification. 11 CA ADC § 1208

- (a) A peace officer certification may be temporarily suspended upon the determination by the Executive Director of the commission it is in the best interest of the health, safety, or welfare of the public.
- (b) The Executive Director shall order the immediate temporary suspension of any certificate held by the peace officer upon one of the following circumstances:
 - (1) Arrest or indictment of a peace officer for any crime described in Government Code Section 1029,
 - (2) <u>Discharge from any law enforcement agency if the person is or has become</u> ineligible to hold office as a peace officer pursuant to Government Code Section 1029, or
 - (3) <u>Separation from employment of a peace officer pending investigation into allegations of serious misconduct.</u>
- (c) Following the order of temporary suspension, the division shall take the following steps:
 - (1) Notify the involved peace officer and agency head in writing. The notification shall specify the basis for the Executive Director's determination.
 - (2) The commission shall schedule proceedings as soon as practicable.
- (d) The temporary suspension shall continue in effect until the final decision on revocation or until the order is withdrawn by the Executive Director.
