## Text of Proposed Regulatory Action § 1012. Conditions for Continuing Employment. 11 CCR § 1012

- (a) Every full-time peace officer employed by a participating department shall be required to serve in a probationary status for not less than 12 months from the date appointed to a full-time peace officer position.
- (b) In order to exercise peace officer powers, any individual appointed to a peace officer position pursuant to Penal Code Section 830.1(a) who is not yet eligible for a Basic Certificate, shall obtain a Proof of Eligibility (POE) pursuant to Penal Code Section 13510.1.
  - (1) The POE shall remain valid until such time as the individual separates from the employing agency or becomes eligible for and obtains a Basic Certificate.
- (cb) In order to continue to exercise peace officer powers, any individual appointed to a full-time peace officer position pursuant to Penal Code <a href="Section 830.1">Section 830.1</a>(a) must obtain a <a href="bbBasic eCertificate">bBasic eCertificate</a> as set forth in Penal Code <a href="Section 832.4">Section 832.4</a>.
